5. The national dish is The national dish is Cou-Cou and flying fish.

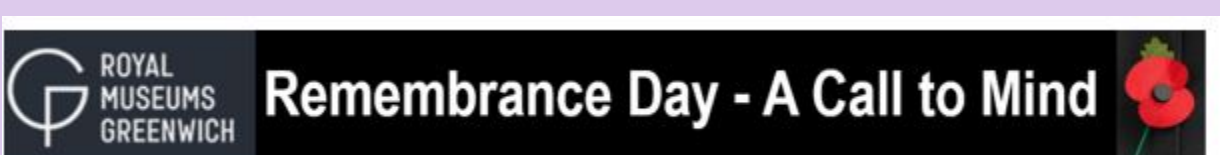
