Safety



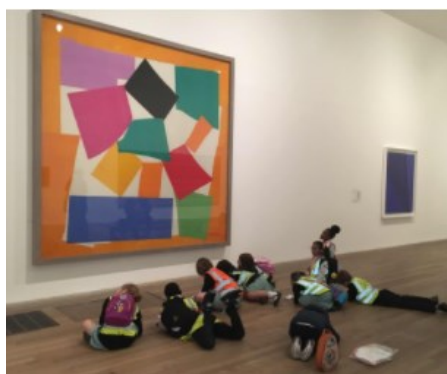
