Dear Year 7 Trinitarians and families,

It is so exciting that we are able to welcome you back to school full time on **Monday 7th September.** As I am sure you can understand there have been a few changes at school to ensure we are all kept safe as a result of the Covid Pandemic. Year 8 will be kept in a year group Bubble and will only be interacting with others in the Bubble. Within their Bubble students are advised to maintain social distance. Teachers and other staff will be going between Bubbles so will **alway**s ensure they socially distance from students and each other.

There will be a slight change to the year 8 school day. You will <u>not</u> be using the main school entrance. You will need to arrive between 8:30 and 8:45 on the '*Cage*' at Manor House Gardens. You will be collected from here by your Family Group Leader at 8:45 (Do not be late). The specific arrival time is to stagger arrivals for different year groups and ensure all are kept in their year group Bubbles.

There will be a sixth family group in year 8 to ensure that class sizes remain no larger than 22 and to help practice social distancing in the classroom. There will also be six teaching groups for the same reason. You will find out your family groups on your first day back in September

Year 8 will be based on the Humanities corridor on the second floor. This means that all your lessons will take place in the same room in order to reduce movement around the building. Teachers will be coming to you for your lessons.

Your social space for break time and lunch time will be The Learning Deck on the second floor. Sandwiches ca be pre ordered during family group and will be delivered to your social space during lunchtime. Free school meals will receive a sandwich lunch. I would however urge you to bring a packed lunch if at all possible.

At the end of your school day (15:15) you will be dismissed by your period 6 teachers at the Manor House Gardens Gate. Students are expected to make their way straight home and not wait around after school.

Please also be aware that pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school and to <u>not</u> use public transport if at all possible. If using public transport face masks must be worn. Parents will also not be permitted on site unless a pre-arranged appointment has been organised. It is vital that students arrive at their allotted time and entry point to avoid mixing with other Bubbles and this therefore cuts down the risk of disease transmission.

Teachers have put together a list of challenges to complete for all subjects over the summer in the 'Summer Work Book'. These will both extend students' knowledge in each subject as well as build cultural capital to start the new academic year with rigour. I would urge you to have a go at all of these challenges.
