Life source, sacred ritual, scarce commodity? Seven artists share what water means to them at the National Maritime Museum

Water is a vital resource, but, to many, it holds a sacred significance. Beyond its uses for cleaning and drinking, water is central to many cultural and spiritual practices around the world.

Our Connection to Water, a free exhibition at the National Maritime Museum brings together seven artists; *Aya Mohamed, Artemis Evlogimenou, Dafe Oboro, Giya Makondo-Wills, JIUN Collective, Paul Malone* and *Seba Calfuqueo*. Their work, influenced by their different backgrounds and experiences, explores our human connection to water.

Through photography, audio, film, illustration, and installations, they share their perceptions of and relationships to water, and consider how it impacts their communities socially, culturally, environmentally, emotionally and spiritually. Feel the water's pull.
