The Big Half:

The Big Half is a new one-day running festival organised by the London Marathon. It takes place on Sunday 4 March 2018 and will feature a half marathon, relay and the little half a 2.4 mile run for kids and families. Trinity has been given exclusive access to places and the pupils will be designing some of the posters that will line the route. We are encouraging all parents, teachers and pupils to get involved. Whether you are an experienced runner or have never put on a pair of trainers before we would like you to take part. There are three different running events:

The Big Half – a half marathon that starts at Tower Bridge and finishes by the Cutty Sark – min age 17

The Little Half – a 2.4 mile run for all ages and abilities, which starts in Southwark Park and finishes at the Cutty Sark

The Big Relay – for teams of four (age 12 or over) with each person running one leg of The Big Half course over distances from one to five miles.

If any children want to run The Little Half (free to enter) and raise money for one of PAFT's projects by asking their friends and family to sponsor them, PAFT will be providing a sponsorship form nearer the time. If any parents want to do the same running The Big Half please talk to Hayley Atwere, who will coordinate the application for the places (the cost of these places are £10). Or if 13 miles is too far for you, join with other parents to run The Big Relay (cost of entry £16). Again, talk to Hayley to obtain a place.
